Keep Charlotte Beautiful Scholarship Program Guidelines

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Keep Charlotte Beautiful Scholarship Program is to recognize and celebrate graduating high school seniors who embody the vision of KCB to inspire and educate people to take action every day to improve and beautify Charlotte County.

FUNDING:

1. KCB has a special scholarship fund.
2. The amount awarded may be up to \$500.00 per recipient.
3. There may be more than one recipient, if sufficient funds are available.
4. The scholarship will be for one year.
5. Payment will be made after KCB has received confirmation of full-time enrollment.
6. The funds will be paid directly to the college or school unless this will affect the student's award package with the school. Then KCB will give the student the check.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible the student applicant shall:

1. Be a senior in high school planning to attend college/post-secondary instruction.
2. Be currently active with KCB and will have maintained continuous involvement for 3 years.
3. Submit an application completed in full by March 1, 2022.

It is essential that all eligibility requirements are met.

The decisions of the scholarship committee are final. Consideration is based on the quality of the application. Having continuous involvement in the Youth Advisory Council and/or Community Appearance Index will be strongly considered by the committee.
